PREAMBLE TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA • Mary Richmond

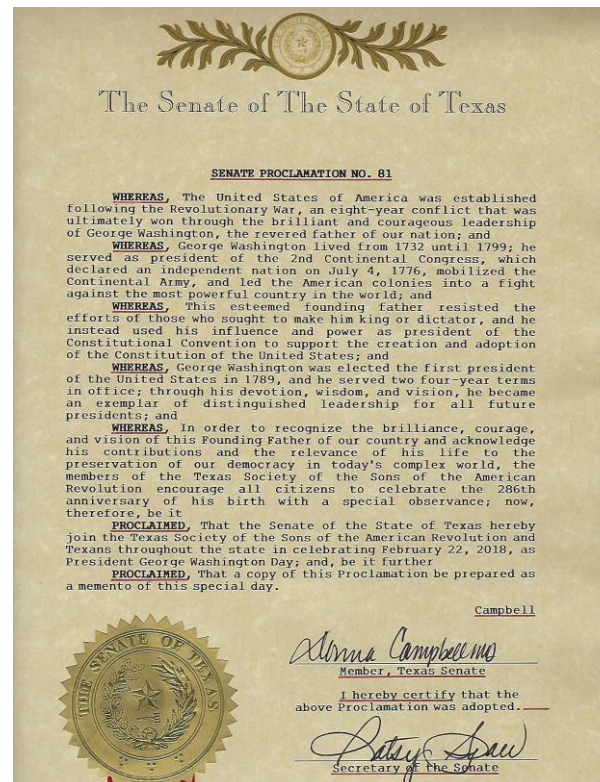

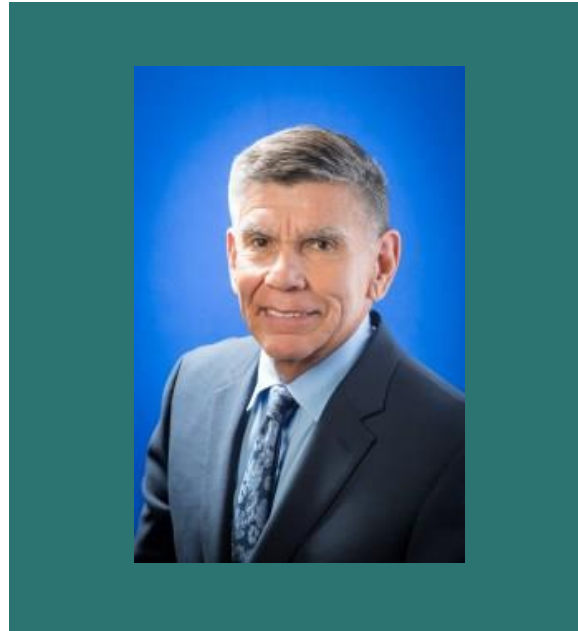
